



DISASTER COMMUNICATIONS

IN A CHANGING MEDIA WORLD







Government official Chet Lunner explained his unease in the Aspen report: "I get concerned when I see the term "citizen journalists" and "blogs" lumped in with everything else as if that were journalism in the way that it is practiced by professionals. That is often the problem we have, which is that something that starts out as a blog does not necessarily meet the standards of most source-tested journalism that has been in practice for all these years... We have enough trouble with things that do go through the [mainstream media] filter. The amount of time and energy and social unrest by readers and/or the people trying to practice in the field dealing with these things that are exaggerated rumors, etc., is a problem, particularly in the framework of these disaster times when people are depending upon or relying on that."[16]

"On the other hand," the editor of NOLA.com explained, "the very first reports [that] we had of life threatening flooding in New Orleans came from citizens typing it into cell phones. The very first news we had of clear levee breaks, of looting, of a shooting death, or a suicide in the

loosened, Mashable, an online site that covers social networking news, reported that in the regions hardest hit by the quake, generators were brought to special buildings to allow people to recharge their mobile phones and crews made repairing cell towers affected by the quake and subsequent aftershocks a priority so "information could flow with as few complications as possible." In addition, the Chinese language "Wikipedia" site on the 2008 Sichuan earthquake was set up more quickly than its English-language counterpart—despite the fact that Wikipedia Chinese had been blocked from within China. [9]

Other online and new media tools included scores of user-shot videos on YouTube that captured the moments the quake struck, bulletin boards to help relatives and friends locate missing people, a channel on QQ Prayer to report fundraising scams and a map mashup on Netease that allowed users in Wenchuan to report in live time what was happening in their area. In addition to using online technology to report on the earthquake damage, Chinese citizens also used the same tools to expedite the recovery. According to *The Washington Post*, the nation's "wary rulers" allowed grassroots groups and informal networks, "aided by the proliferation of online bulletin boards, blogs, and on-the ground-coordination centers" to function as legitimate relief organizations. 


Volunteers used e-mail, text messages, and cell phones to gather information on where help or supplies were needed and to direct relief. "No one from the government told us what to do. In this urgent situation, we decided to share some of the responsibility," one of the volunteer coordinators told *The Washington Post*.



Energy Agency's Facebook Updates

The International Atomic Energy Agency is providing updates on the Japanese nuclear plant on its Facebook page.

Here's the latest update, from 7:47 a.m. Eastern:

Japan's Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) has informed the IAEA's Incident and Emergency Centre (IEC) that there has been an explosion at the Unit 1 reactor at the Fukushima Daiichi plant, and that they are assessing the condition of the reactor core. The explosion was reported to NISA by the plant operator, TEPCO, at 0730 CET. Further details were not immediately available.

Japanese authorities have extended the evacuation zone around the Fukushima Daiichi plant to a 20-kilometre radius from the previous 10 kilometres. At the nearby Fukushima Daini nuclear power plant, the evacuation zone has been extended to a 10-kilometre radius from the previous three kilometres.


The authorities also say they are making preparations to distribute iodine to residents in the area of both the plants.




